ESV	He chose our heritage for us, the pride of Jacob whom he loves. Selah
NIV	He chose our inheritance for us, the pride of Jacob, whom he loved. Selah
NLT	He chose the Promised Land as our inheritance, the proud possession of Jacob's descendants, whom he loves. Interlude

It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἡγάπησεν διάψαλμα
