Hebrew	רוּחַ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew Meaning: * Wind * Breath * Spirit Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament. Though usually feminine, רוּחַ sometimes takes masculine verbs and adjectives, especially when referring to the Spirit of God (רוּחַ יְהוָה).Exodus 10:13Genesis 6:17Genesis 41:8Proverbs 16:32Ecclesiastes 12:7Genesis 1:2Judges 3:10Ezekiel 36:27Genesis 2:7John 3:8Genesis 1:2Genesis 8:1 קָדִים תִּשְׁבֶּר אֲנִיּוֹת תְּרִשִׁישׁ
ESV	As we have heard, so have we seen in the city of the LORD of hosts, in the city of our God, which God will establish forever. Selah
NIV	As we have heard, so have we seen in the city of the LORD Almighty, in the city of our God: God makes her secure forever. Selah
NLT	We had heard of the city's glory, but now we have seen it ourselves- the city of the LORD of Heaven's Armies. It is the city of our God; he will make it safe forever. Interlude
