Meaning

* Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial

Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament.

From the root קָרַב, meaning "to come near, approach." So קָרַב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7 Psalm 103:1 הָיוּתָה קָרַב פְּתוּחַ גְּרוֹנִים לְשׁוֹנִם יַחְלִיקוּ

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
