Hebrew	hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again.
