Hebrew	לִמְנַצֵּחַ עַל מַחְלַת מַשְׁכִּיל לְדָוִד
ESV	TO THE CHOIRMASTER: ACCORDING TO MAHALATH. A MASKIL OF DAVID. The fool says in his heart, “There is no God.” They are corrupt, doing abominable iniquity; there is none who does good.
NIV	The fool says in his heart, “There is no God.” They are corrupt, and their ways are vile; there is no one who does good.
NLT	Only fools say in their hearts, “There is no God.” They are corrupt, and their actions are evil; not one of them does good!

LXX	εἰς τὸ greek The definite article τέλος ὑπὲρ μαλεθ συνέσεως τῷ greek The definite article Δαυιδ εἶπεν ἄφρων ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. καρδίᾳ αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) οὐκ ἔστιν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐβδελύχθησαν ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἀνομίαις οὐκ ἔστιν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
