Hebrew	הֲנִי אֶרְחֹק נֶגֶד אֱלֹיוּ בְּמַדְבָּר סֶלָה
ESV	I would hurry to find a shelter from the raging wind and tempest."
NIV	I would hurry to my place of shelter, far from the tempest and storm."
NLT	How quickly I would escape- far from this wild storm of hatred.
LXX	προσεδεχόμεν τὸν greek The definite article σώζοντά με ἀπὸ ὀλιγοψυχίας καὶ autotooltip_bigκαί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" καταιγίδος
KJV	I would hasten my escape from the windy storm and tempest.
