	הָיָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 לִי מְשֹׁבֵב לִי מְנוּס בְּיָם צָר
ESV	O my Strength, I will sing praises to you, for you, O God, are my fortress, the God who shows me steadfast love.
NIV	O my Strength, I sing praise to you; you, O God, are my fortress, my loving God.
NLT	O my Strength, to you I sing praises, for you, O God, are my refuge, the God who shows me unfailing love. For the choir director: A psalm of David useful for teaching, regarding the time David fought Aram-naharaim and Aram-zobah, and Joab returned and killed 12,000 Edomites in the Valley of Salt. To be sung to the tune “Lily of the Testimony.”
LXX	βοηθός μου σοὶ ψαλῶ ὅτι ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek The definite article θεόςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεὸς greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God ἀντιλήμπτωρ μου εἶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big εἶμί greek εἶμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek The definite article θεόςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεὸς greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God μου τὸ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὁ greek The definite article ἑλός μου
