Hebrew	יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big יהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. ESV	Be gracious to me, O LORD, for I am languishing; heal me, O LORD, for my bones are troubled.
NIV	Be merciful to me, LORD, for I am faint; O LORD, heal me, for my bones are in agony.
NLT	Have compassion on me, LORD, for I am weak. Heal me, LORD, for my bones are in agony.
LXX	ἐλέησόν με κύριε ὅτι ἀσθενής εἰμι plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big εἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἰασαί με κύριε ὅτι ἐταράχθη τὰ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὁ greek The definite article ὁ στή μου
