	אֶרֶץ־הָרַעַשְׁתָּהּ אֶרֶץ־ hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1
ESV	You have set up a banner for those who fear you, that they may flee to it from the bow. Selah
NIV	But for those who fear you, you have raised a banner to be unfurled against the bow. Selah
NLT	But you have raised a banner for those who fear you- a rallying point in the face of attack. Interlude
LXX	ἔδωκας τοῖς greek The definite article φοβουμένοις σε σημείωσιν τοῦ autotooltip_big0 greek The definite article φυγεῖν ἀπὸ προσώπου τόξου διάψαλμα
KJV	Thou hast given a banner to them that fear thee, that it may be displayed because of the truth. Selah.

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
