Hebrew	לִירוֹת בַּמִּסְתָּרִים תָּם פְּתָאִם יִרְהוּ וְלֹא יֵרְאוּ
ESV	They hold fast to their evil purpose; they talk of laying snares secretly, thinking, who can see them?
NIV	They encourage each other in evil plans, they talk about hiding their snares; they say, "Who will see them?"
NLT	They encourage each other to do evil and plan how to set their traps in secret. "Who will ever notice?" they ask.
LXX	ἐκκραταίωσαν ἑαυτοῖς λόγον Meaning * A word or words * Statement * Message * Speech * Account * Used in John to mean God the Son Masculine noun. Related to the verb λέγω. λόγος in Greek Thought Before the New Testament, λόγος already had deep philosophical use. In Greek philosophy, λόγος was the rational principle that ordered the universe, the divine reason that structured all things. In Heraclitus, λόγος referred to the unifying rational principle behind the constant change in the world.... πονηρόν διηγήσαντο τοῦ greek Meaning: * The The definite article.
