ESV	that which my lips uttered and my mouth promised when I was in trouble.
NIV	vows my lips promised and my mouth spoke when I was in trouble.
NLT	yes, the sacred vows that I made when I was in deep trouble.
LXX	ὅς διέστειλεν τὰ greek The definite article χεῖλη μου καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐλάλησεν τὸ greek The definite article στόμα μου ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τῇ greek The definite article θλίψει μου
KJV	Which my lips have uttered, and my mouth hath spoken, when I was in trouble.
