Hebrew	עֲלֹת מִחִים אֶעֱלֶה לָּךְ עִם קִטְרֶת אֵילִים אֶעֱשֶׂה בְּקָר עִם עֲתוּדִים סֶלָה
ESV	I will offer to you burnt offerings of fattened animals, with the smoke of the sacrifice of rams; I will make an offering of bulls and goats. Selah
NIV	I will sacrifice fat animals to you and an offering of rams; I will offer bulls and goats. Selah
NLT	That is why I am sacrificing burnt offerings to you- the best of my rams as a pleasing aroma, and a sacrifice of bulls and male goats. Interlude
LXX	ὀλοκαυτώματα μεμναλωμένα ἀνοίσω σοι μετὰ θυμιάματος καὶ ποιήσω σοι βοῶντα καὶ κριῶντα greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences.
