	אֱלֹהִים hebrew Meanings: * God * god * goddess * divine ones * angels Noun, masculine אֱלֹהִים Meaning * To kneel * To bless God as an act of adoration * To bless man as a benefit * Sometimes, to curse Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament. The word אֱלֹהִים marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. Genesis 1:28Psalms 103:1Numbers 6:24 hebrew Meaning: * To be light * To shine * To give light * To illuminate Verb occurring around 20 times in the Old Testament. It is sometimes used literally, and, at other times, figuratively. Biblical Examples Intransitive sense Used when light itself shines or dawns. Isaiah 60:1Exodus 13:21 hebrew Meaning: * Face * Presence * Front or surface Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. אֲנִי פָנִים

NLT	May your ways be known throughout the earth, your saving power among people everywhere.

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
