Hebrew	אֶרֶץ לְאֻמִּים יִשְׁמְחוּ וְיִרְנְנוּ לְאֻמִּים כִּי תִשְׁפֹּט עַמִּים מִיִּשְׂרָאֵל וּלְאֻמִּים בְּאֶרֶץ autotooltip_big hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 תִּנְחֶם סֵלָה

NIV	May the peoples praise you, O God; may all the peoples praise you.
NLT	May the nations praise you, O God. Yes, may all the nations praise you.

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
