	בָּרַךְ בְּמִקְהֵלוֹת בָּרְכוּ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big Meaning * To kneel * To bless God as an act of adoration * To bless man as a benefit * Sometimes, to curse Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament. The word בָּרַךְ marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. Genesis 1:28 Psalm 103:1 Numbers 6:24 אֱלֹהִים plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big אֱלֹהִים hebrew Meanings: Hebrew * God * god * goddess * divine ones * angels Noun, masculine יְהוָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big יְהוָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. ESV	There is Benjamin, the least of them, in the lead, the princes of Judah in their throng, the princes of Zebulun, the princes of Naphtali.
NIV	There is the little tribe of Benjamin, leading them, there the great throng of Judah's princes, and there the princes of Zebulun and of Naphtali.
NLT	Look, the little tribe of Benjamin leads the way. Then comes a great throng of rulers from Judah and all the rulers of Zebulun and Naphtali.

LXX	ἐκεῖ Βενιαμιν νεώτερος ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἐκστάσει ἄρχοντες Ιουδα ἡγεμόνες αὐτῶν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἄρχοντες Ζαβουλων ἄρχοντες Νεφθαλι
KJV	There is little Benjamin with their ruler, the princes of Judah and their council, the princes of Zebulun, and the princes of Naphtali.

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
