	הִתְהַלֵּךְ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big הִתְהַלֵּךְ? hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name Hebrew It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word הִתְהַלֵּךְ (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.
