ESV	I have become a stranger to my brothers, an alien to my mother's sons.
NIV	I am a stranger to my brothers, an alien to my own mother's sons;
NLT	Even my own brothers pretend they don't know me; they treat me like a stranger.
LXX	ἀπηλλοτριωμένος ἐγενήθην τοῖς greek The definite article ἀδελφοῖς μου καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ξένος τοῖς greek The definite article υἱοῖς τῆς greek The definite article μητρός μου
