ESV	let the enemy pursue my soul and overtake it, and let him trample my life to the ground and lay my glory in the dust. Selah
NIV	then let my enemy pursue and overtake me; let him trample my life to the ground and make me sleep in the dust. Selah
NLT	then let my enemies capture me. Let them trample me into the ground and drag my honor in the dust. Interlude

IT is most frequently translated as “and” καταπατήσαι εἰς γῆν Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 τὴν greek The definite article ζωὴν μου καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences.
