ESV	For you, O Lord, are my hope, my trust, O LORD, from my youth.
NIV	For you have been my hope, O Sovereign LORD, my confidence since my youth.
NLT	O Lord, you alone are my hope. I've trusted you, O LORD, from childhood.

	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἦ
