Hebrew	קָרַב plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew Meaning * Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament. From the root קָרַב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קָרַב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalm 103:1 חִיקָן כָּלָה
	ESV Why do you hold back your hand, your right hand? Take it from the fold of your garment and destroy them!
	NIV Why do you hold back your hand, your right hand? Take it from the folds of your garment and destroy them!
	NLT Why do you hold back your strong right hand? Unleash your powerful fist and destroy them.
