Hebrew	יְהוָה יִזְכֹּר אֶת אֹיְבֵי חֲרָף יְהוָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. ESV	Remember this, O LORD, how the enemy scoffs, and a foolish people reviles your name.
NIV	Remember how the enemy has mocked you, O LORD, how foolish people have reviled your name.
NLT	See how these enemies insult you, LORD. A foolish nation has dishonored your name.
LXX	μνήσθητι ταύτης greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἐχθρός ὠνείδισεν τὸν greek The definite article κύριον καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” λαὸς ἄφρων παρώξυνεν τὸν greek The definite article ὄνομά σου
