ESV	Let not the downtrodden turn back in shame; let the poor and needy praise your name.
NIV	Do not let the oppressed retreat in disgrace; may the poor and needy praise your name.
NLT	Don't let the downtrodden be humiliated again. Instead, let the poor and needy praise your name.
