Hebrew	אַתָּה נִזְרָא אֶתְּהָ וּמִי יַעֲמֹד לִפְנֵיךָ מֵאִז אֶפְרָיִם
ESV	From the heavens you uttered judgment; the earth feared and was still,
NIV	From heaven you pronounced judgment, and the land feared and was quiet-
NLT	From heaven you sentenced your enemies; the earth trembled and stood silent before you.
LXX	ἐκ τοῦ greek The definite article οὐρανοῦ Meaning: * The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens 278 occurrences in the New Testament. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 ἡκούτισας κρίσιν γῆ Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 ἐφοβήθη καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἡσύχασεν
