ESV	Then I said, "I will appeal to this, to the years of the right hand of the Most High."
NIV	Then I thought, "To this I will appeal: the years of the right hand of the Most High."
NLT	And I said, "This is my fate; the Most High has turned his hand against me."
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" εἶπα οὖν ἡρξάμην αὕτη αὕτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἡ greek The definite article ἀλλοίως τῆς greek The definite article δεξιᾶς τοῦ greek The definite article ὑψίστου
