ESV	I will remember the deeds of the LORD; yes, I will remember your wonders of old.
NIV	I will remember the deeds of the LORD; yes, I will remember your miracles of long ago.
NLT	But then I recall all you have done, O LORD; I remember your wonderful deeds of long ago.
LXX	ἐμνήσθητι πάντων greek The definite article ἔργων κυρίου ὅτι μνησθήσομαι ἀπὸ τῆς greek The definite article ἀρχῆς greek Meaning: * Beginning * First * Elementary * Rulers, rule, domain Noun, feminine (first declension) Occurs 56 times in the New Testament, consistently conveying the idea of primacy - whether temporal (i.e. the start, e.g. John 1:1) or causal (i.e. the source) or governmental (i.e. the ruler, e.g. Ephesians 6:12 πάντων) greek The definite article θαυμασίων σου
KJV	I will remember the works of the LORD: surely I will remember thy wonders of old.

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
