Hebrew	לָהֶם אֲבִירִים אָכַל אִישׁ צִדָּה שֶׁלָּהֶם לֶחֶם לְשֹׁבַע
ESV	Man ate of the bread of the angels; he sent them food in abundance.
NIV	Men ate the bread of angels; he sent them all the food they could eat.
NLT	They ate the food of angels! God gave them all they could hold.
LXX	ἄρτον ἀγγέλων ἔφαγεν ἄνθρωπος ἐπισιτισμὸν ἀπέστειλεν αὐτοῖς αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) εἰς πλησμονήν
KJV	Man did eat angels' food: he sent them meat to the full.

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
