Hebrew	שָׁמַיִם שָׁמַיִם hebrew Meanings: * Heaven or heavens * Sky * Compass Masculine noun. The word is dual in form (ending in -ים) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20Psalm 115:3 וַיִּנְהַג בְּעַזּוֹ תִּימֹן
ESV	He caused the east wind to blow in the heavens, and by his power he led out the south wind;
NIV	He let loose the east wind from the heavens and led forth the south wind by his power.
NLT	He released the east wind in the heavens and guided the south wind by his mighty power.

Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present.
