Hebrew	וַיַּטֵּשׁ מִשְׁכָּן שְׁלֹוֹ אֶל־הַשֶּׁנֶּרֶב בְּאַדְמָה
ESV	He forsook his dwelling at Shiloh, the tent where he dwelt among mankind,
NIV	He abandoned the tabernacle of Shiloh, the tent he had set up among men.
NLT	Then he abandoned his dwelling at Shiloh, the Tabernacle where he had lived among the people.
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἀπώσατο τὴν greek The definite article σκηνὴν Σηλωμ σκηνωμα αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) οὗ κατεσκήνωσεν ἐν greek Preposition meaning "in". ἀνθρώποις
