ESV	You make us an object of contention for our neighbors, and our enemies laugh among themselves.
NIV	You have made us a source of contention to our neighbors, and our enemies mock us.
NLT	You have made us the scorn of neighboring nations. Our enemies treat us as a joke.
LXX	ἔθου ἡμᾶς εἰς ἀντιλογίαν τοῖς greek The definite article γείτοσιν ἡμῶν καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” οἱ greek The definite article ἐχθροὶ ἡμῶν ἐμυκτήρισαν ἡμᾶς
