ESV	In the day of my trouble I call upon you, for you answer me.
NIV	In the day of my trouble I will call to you, for you will answer me.
NLT	I will call to you whenever I'm in trouble, and you will answer me.
LXX	ἐν greek Preposition meaning "in". ἡμέρᾳ θλίψεώς μου ἐκέκραξα πρὸς greek Meaning * To or towards * Pertaining to (genitive case) * Near to (dative case) * According to * About Preposition. Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again.
