Hebrew	יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigיהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 יְסֹפֵר בְּכִתּוּב עֲמִים זֶה יֵלֵד שָׁם סֵלָה
ESV	The LORD records as he registers the peoples, “This one was born there.” Selah
NIV	The LORD will write in the register of the peoples: “This one was born in Zion.” Selah
NLT	When the LORD registers the nations, he will say, “They have all become citizens of Jerusalem.” Interlude

	κύριος διηγῆσεται ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. γραφῇ λαῶν καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀρχόντων τούτων greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it LXX Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 τῶν greek The definite article γεγενημένων ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. αὐτῇ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
