Hebrew	הוּא יִקְרָאֵנִי אָבִי אֶתְּהָ אֵלֵי וְצִוֵּר יְשׁוּעָתִי
ESV	And I will make him the firstborn, the highest of the kings of the earth.
NIV	I will also appoint him my firstborn, the most exalted of the kings of the earth.
NLT	I will make him my firstborn son, the mightiest king on earth.
LXX	κἀγὼ πρωτότοκον θήσομαι αὐτόν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ὕψηλόν παρὰ τοῖς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek The definite article βασιλεῦσιν τῆς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek The definite article γῆς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big γῆ Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1
KJV	Also I will make him my firstborn, higher than the kings of the earth.

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
