	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

	משיח Messiah means “anointed one” The Greek word is Christ (Χριστός) Masculine, noun
