ESV	A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.
NIV	A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.
NLT	Though a thousand fall at your side, though ten thousand are dying around you, these evils will not touch you.
LXX	πρὸς αὐτὸν ἐκ τοῦ greek The definite article κλίτους σου χιλιάς καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” μυριάς ἐκ δεξιῶν σου πρὸς greek Meaning * To or towards * Pertaining to (genitive case) * Near to (dative case) * According to * About Preposition. Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρός is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. At its core, it usually describes movement or relationship toward someone or something, whether physical, s... ὁ δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. οὐκ ἐγγίξει
