	אַרְצָאָרץ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אָרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 הָשָׁב לְמוֹלַעַל גַּאִים
ESV	Rise up, O judge of the earth; repay to the proud what they deserve!
NIV	Rise up, O Judge of the earth; pay back to the proud what they deserve.
NLT	Arise, O judge of the earth. Give the proud what they deserve.

Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.
