Hebrew	הֵיחֵיָהּ שְׁמִי חַדִּיקִים בְּיָהּ hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word הֵיחֵיָהּ (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. 	εὐφράνθητε δίκαιοι ἐπὶ τῷ greek The definite article κυρίῳ καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐξομολογεῖσθε τῇ greek The definite article μνήμῃ τῆς greek The definite article ἁγιοσύνης αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
