Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 ὀπίσω τοῦplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article θηρίου,

ESV	One of its heads seemed to have a mortal wound, but its mortal wound was healed, and the whole earth marveled as they followed the beast.
NIV	One of the heads of the beast seemed to have had a fatal wound, but the fatal wound had been healed. The whole world was astonished and followed the beast.
NLT	I saw that one of the heads of the beast seemed wounded beyond recovery- but the fatal wound was healed! The whole world marveled at this miracle and gave allegiance to the beast.
KJV	And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast.
