	Ἰδοὺ ἔρχομαι ταχύ, καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ὅ greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Greek	Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ ἔργον ἐστίν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. αὐτοῦ. greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)

ESV	"Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense with me, to repay everyone for what he has done.
NIV	"Behold, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done.
NLT	"Look, I am coming soon, bringing my reward with me to repay all people according to their deeds.
KJV	And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.
