The definite article [εὐαγγέλιον](#), [εὐαγγέλιον](#)

Means “good news” or “gospel” [δύναμις γὰρ θεοῦ](#) [θεὸς](#)

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Masculine noun meaning:

* A god or goddess * God [ἐστίν](#) [εἰμί](#)

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[εἰμί](#) is the first person singular verb for “to be” ([εἶναι](#) [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example [εἰμί](#) is the word for am and [ἦν](#) is the word for was, e.g. [εἰς σωτηρίαν παντὶ](#) [πάντες](#)

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Meaning

* All * Every * The whole

Adjective.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of [πᾶς](#) depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians 1:16 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 [τῷ](#) [αὐτοῦ](#)

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The definite article [πιστεύοντι](#), [Ἰουδαίῳ τε πρῶτον καὶ](#) [καὶ](#)

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Meaning

* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἔλληνι.

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
