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εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. οὐ μόνον αὐτὰ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.
