εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example  $\epsilon i \mu i$  is the word for am and  $\tilde{\eta} \nu$  is the word for was, e.g.  $\kappa \alpha i \rho lugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_big <math>\kappa \alpha i$

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ὑμεῖς κλητοὶ Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ,plugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip bigΧριστός

Christ means "anointed one"

The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מַשִּיתַ)

Noun, masculine.
