	Verb.	
	Different from εἶμι (which means "to be" - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event. John 1:14 John 1:3 Matthew 6:10 φρόνιμοι παρ' ἑαυτοῖς.	
	ESV	
	Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be conceited.	
	NIV	
	Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.	
	NLT	
	Live in harmony with each other. Don't be too proud to enjoy the company of ordinary people. And don't think you know it all!	
	KJV	
	Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.	

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
