	Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" οὐδεὶς ἑαυτῷ ἀποθνήσκει.
ESV	For none of us lives to himself, and none of us dies to himself.
NIV	For none of us lives to himself alone and none of us dies to himself alone.
NLT	For we don't live for ourselves or die for ourselves.
KJV	For none of us liveth to himself, and no man dieth to himself.
