It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning οὐ κατειργάσατο Χριστὸςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip bigΧριστός

Christ means "anointed one"

The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מַשִּׁיחַ)

Preposition that relates to movement through space, time, means or cause - it's a preposition of movement and mediation.

λόγος in Greek Thought

Before the New Testament, λόγος already had deep philosophical use. In Greek philosophy, λόγος was the rational principle that ordered the universe, the divine reason that structured all things. Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἔργω,

NIV	I will not venture to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me in leading the Gentiles to obey God by what I have said and done-

KJV	For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ hath not wrought by me, to make the Gentiles obedient, by word and deed,
