Sometimes it functions as a indefinitely pronoun (“someone” or “a certain one”). It agrees in gender, number and case with the noun it modifies. Occurs a little under 350 times in the New Testament.Matthew 8:19John 10:30 στόματι δοξάζητε τὸν greek The definite article θεὸν greek Greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” πατέρα τοῦ greek The definite article κυρίου ἡμῶν Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ. Χριστός Christ means “anointed one” The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ) Noun, masculine.
