Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 τοῦ greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ Χριστοῦ. Christ means “anointed one” The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ) Noun, masculine.
	ESV Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ greet you.

NIV	Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ send greetings.
NLT	Greet each other in Christian love. All the churches of Christ send you their greetings.
KJV	Salute one another with an holy kiss. The churches of Christ salute you.

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
