Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ὑμεῖς λογίζεσθε ἑαυτοὺς εἶναι plugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigεἶμί

εἶμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
