δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. δplugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigŏς, ἤ, ὄ

The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).

It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning οὐ θέλω τοῦτορlugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigoὖτος / αὕτη /τοῦτο

Demonstrative pronoun.

## Greek

οὖτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ποιῶ,plugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigποιέω

This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.
