IT is most frequently translated as “and” εἰρήνη·
ESV	To set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace.
NIV	The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace;
NLT	So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace.
KJV	For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

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
