Greek	οὗς greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent). It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning καί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἐκάλεσεν ἡμᾶς οὐ μόνον ἐξ Ἰουδαίων ἀλλὰ καί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἐξ ἐθνῶν;
	ESV even us whom he has called, not from the Jews only but also from the Gentiles?
	NIV even us, whom he also called, not only from the Jews but also from the Gentiles?
	NLT And we are among those whom he selected, both from the Jews and from the Gentiles.
KJV	Even us, whom he hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?
